Identifying a Need

- APhA-ASP chapter members recognized a lack of community amongst current members and undergraduate pre-pharmacy students.
- Incoming student pharmacists often felt lost and did not know anyone when entering pharmacy school.

A New Idea is Born

APhA-ASP chapter members created the first program at the university to help guide students through the transition to pharmacy school by pairing a pre-pharmacy student with a mentor currently in pharmacy school.

Implementation

- Partnered with the College of Pharmacy Department of Admissions
- Collaborated with the undergraduate Sophomore Class President, who was a prepharmacy student, to represent the desires of the pre-pharmacy students
- Invited pre-pharmacy students to APhA-ASP chapter events
- Had sign-ups for mentors in December 2021
- Paired current P1 and P2 chapter members with their undergraduate Phriend
- Announced pairs of Phriends in February 2022
- Provided free coffee coupons to each pair, so they could meet in a relaxed atmosphere
- Held events catered toward Phriend pairs, to encouraged spending time together



"The Spooktacular Pumpkin Carving Party" - The first event of the year that APhA-ASP chapter members invited pre-pharmacy students to attend.

"The End of the Year Party" - The final gathering of the year with nachos, board games, and an opportunity for Phriend pairs to spend time together.



Impact and Outcomes

- More involvement in APhA-ASP events and activities
- A total of 15 mentors and 13 pre-pharmacy students; two pre-pharmacy students had two mentors
- Incoming student pharmacists reported they felt much more prepared entering pharmacy school.

- Continue partnership with the Department of Admissions; more pre-pharmacy student involvement in APhA-ASP activities
