Step 2 - Example

- Define in detail what the goal/priority is.
 - Our chapter will increase member participation and engagement at patient care project events.
- Who will contribute to it?
 - Chapter members (participating)
 - Patient Care Project Chairs and Patient Care VP (planning and execution of events; promoting participation)
 - Communications VP (communicating events and opportunities to chapter members)
- What is the desired outcome?
 - Increased member participation and engagement will lead to an improved experience for chapter members.

Step 2 - Example

- Why is it important?
 - This goal is important to our chapter because since the pandemic we have had a decline in member participation in patient care project events which has led to our chairs feeling burnt out and discouraged. By improving patient care, we will not only make an important impact in the community but will also give our members ample opportunities to practice their skills, bond with fellow chapter members and make a difference in their community.
- How will we accomplish it?
 - We will accomplish this goal by making participation in at least two patient care projects events a semester mandatory of all members. We will track participation and will incentivize those who complete more than the required events. Additionally, we will utilize class schedules to support scheduling events when majority of members are able to attend. Lastly, we will make sure to have adequate communication with the Communications VP to ensure the information can be disseminated to members with plenty of advance warning and that all opportunities are communicated to our members.
- How will we monitor our success towards it?
 - We will utilize a tracking system to monitor member participation. We will also send out a survey to members at the beginning of each semester to get a gauge of what they are interested in participating in as well as what helps them to feel engaged when at an event.
