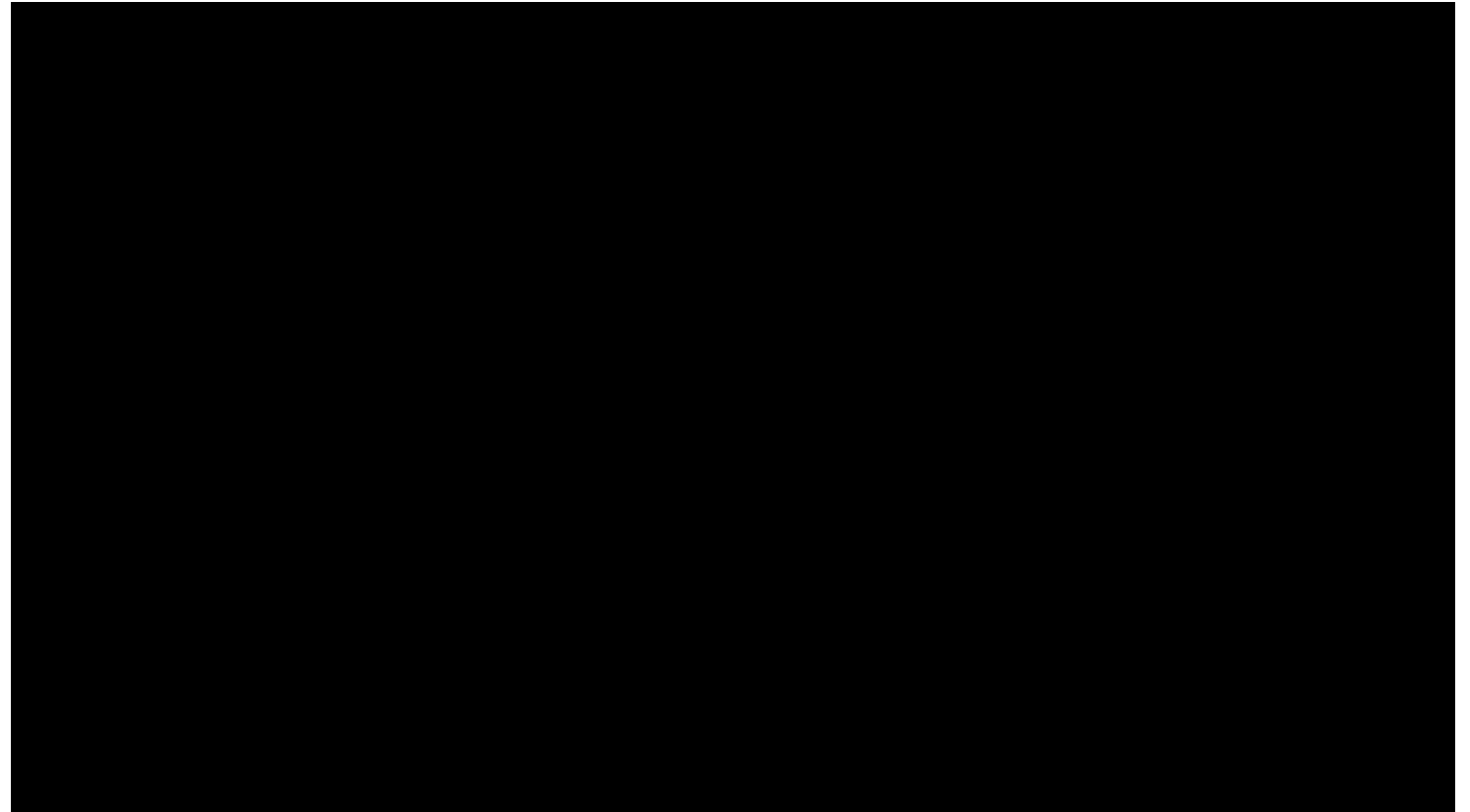



  - **September 2020–September 2022**
- "Chapters may report on a single activity or a series of activities based on a central theme that is original, creative, and sets their chapter apart from all other APhA-ASP Chapters."
- Innovative programs may include patient care and community service projects\*, community outreach, American Pharmacists Month, fundraisers, membership recruitment, fundraising campaigns, change in leadership structure/meeting structure, etc.

### **Regional Level Component**

- Poster presentation at the APhA-ASP Midyear Regional Meeting (MRM)
- Chapter delegate votes during MRM on the most innovative idea

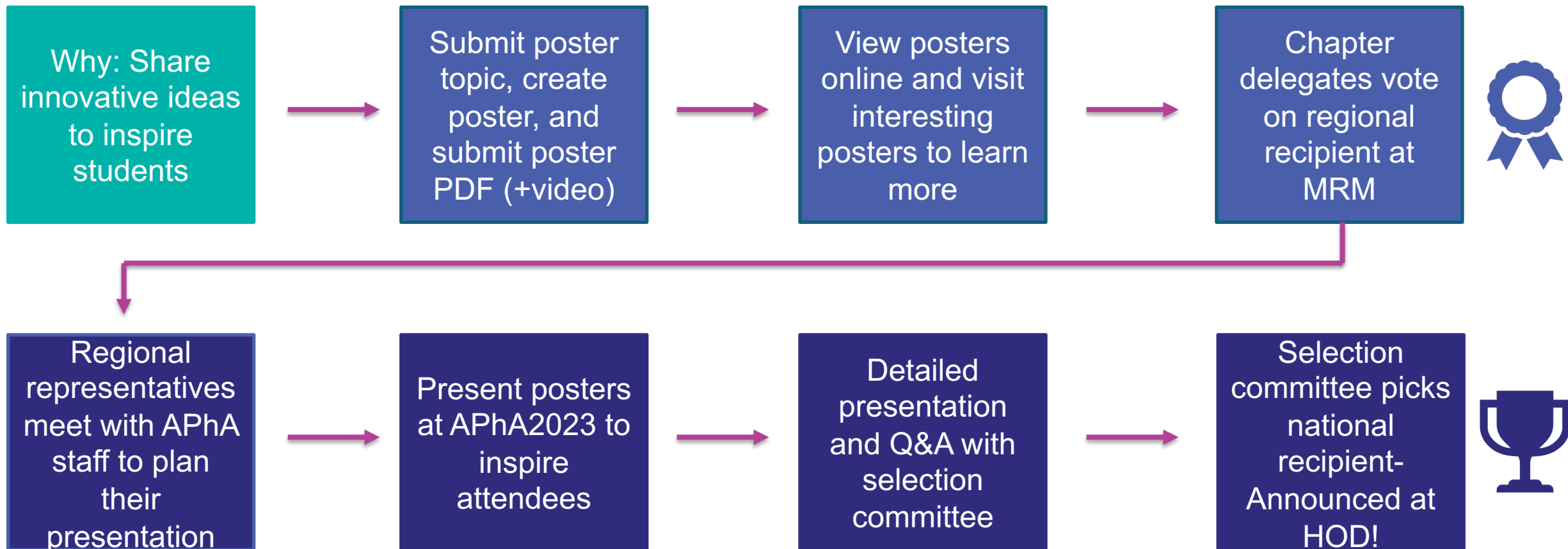
