Background

- Launched in 1997
- 2020-2021
 - 124 chapters participated
 - 13,884 student pharmacists participated
 - 1,716 faculty and staff members participated
 - 2,158 pharmacists participated
 - 1,286,161 patients immunized
 - 1,162,288 patients immunized for COVID-19
 - 82,318 patients immunized for influenza
 - 21,626,012 individuals reached through public relation initiatives


