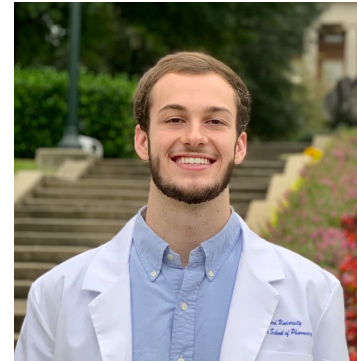

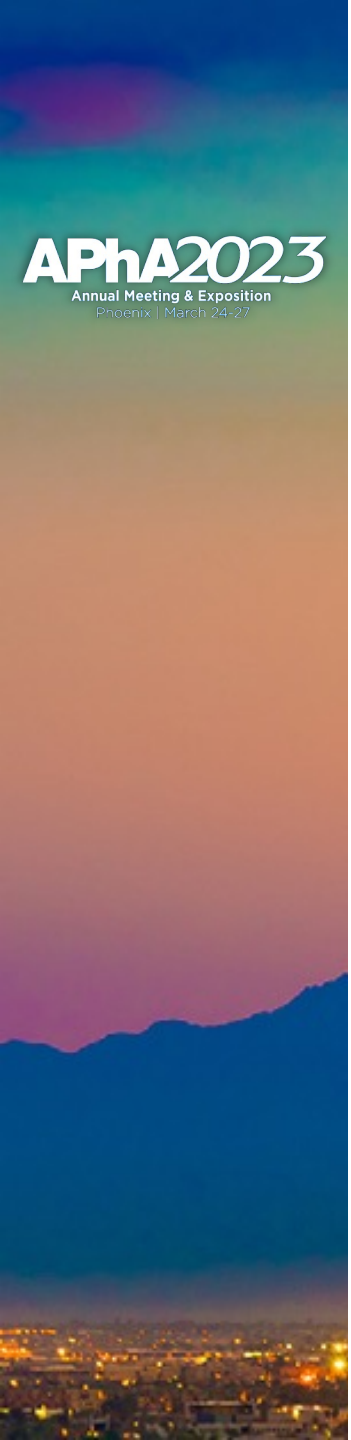

- Chapters can sign up to be a host by reaching out the SEO



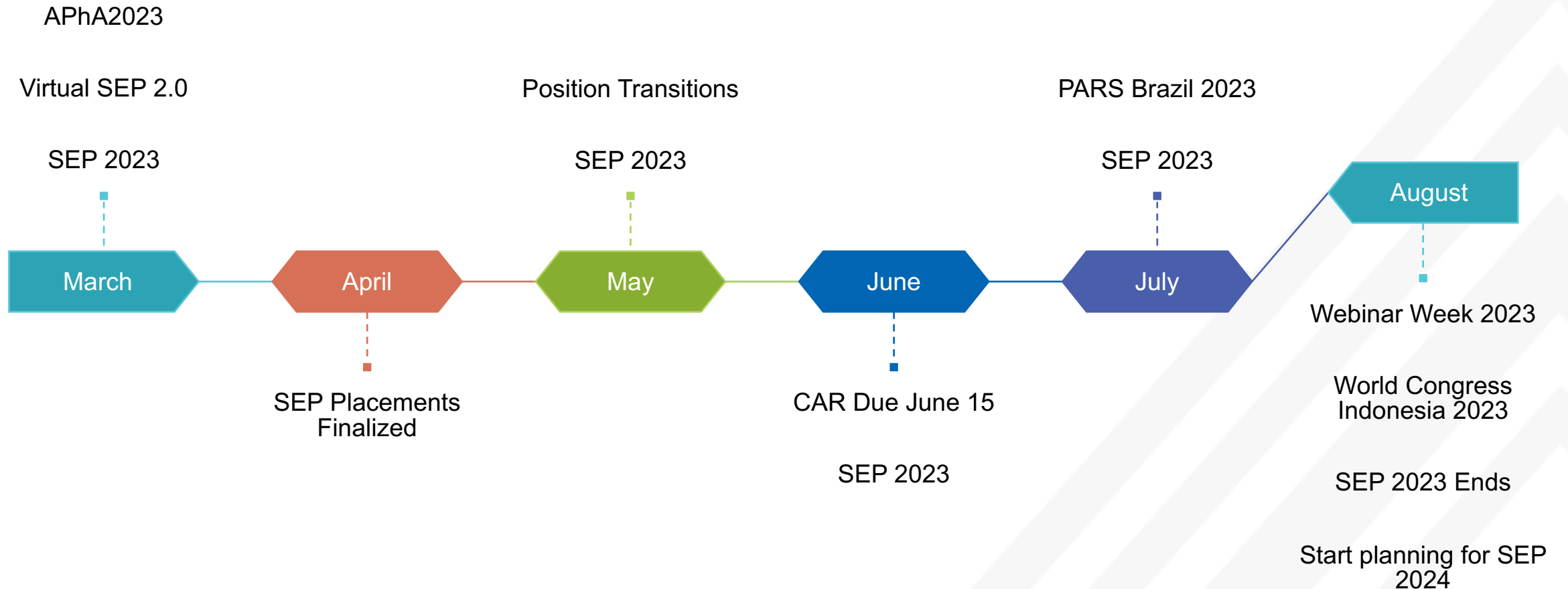

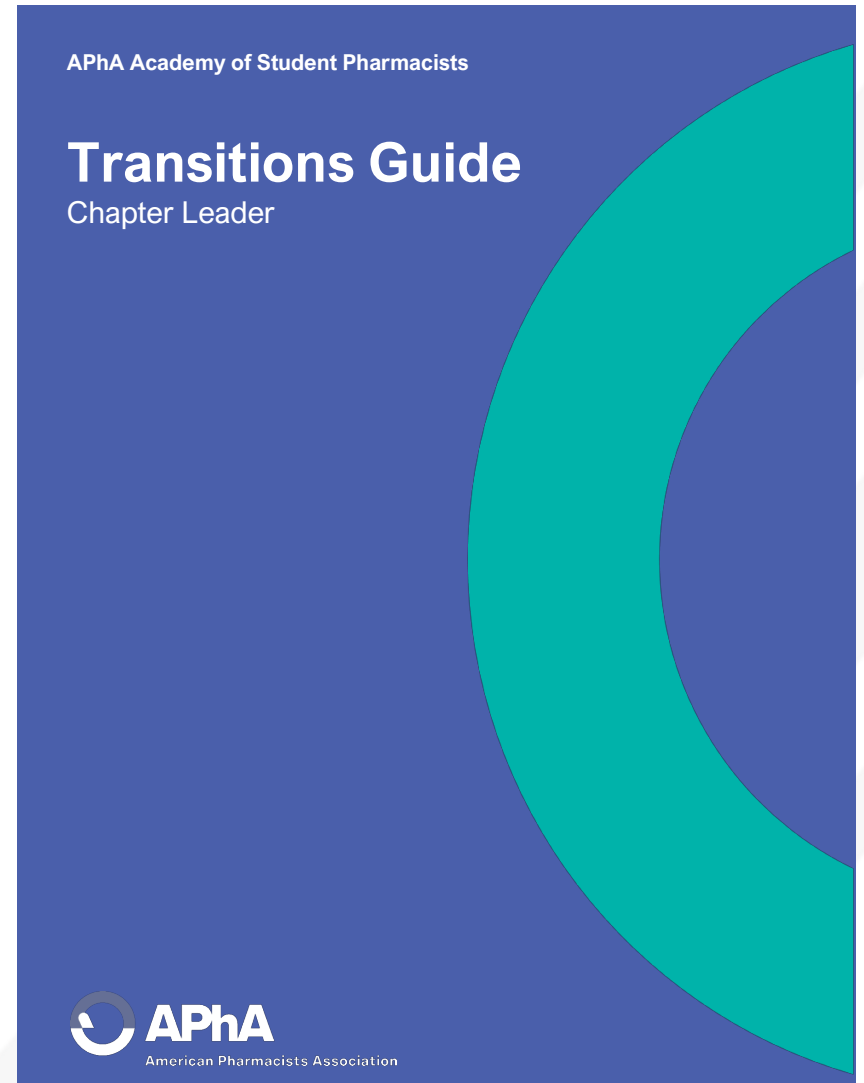
