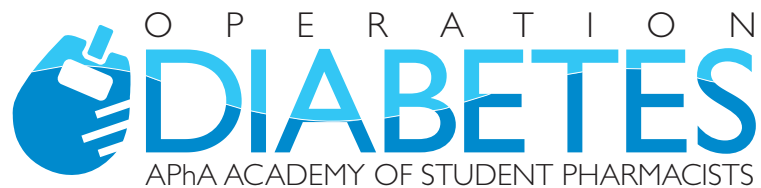

# Operation Heart

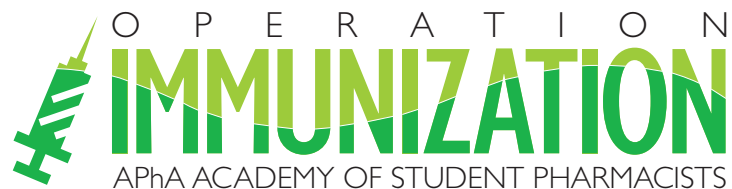
- Provide **education** and **screenings** to keep communities heart healthy including:

- Provide education on reproductive health and sexually transmitted diseases



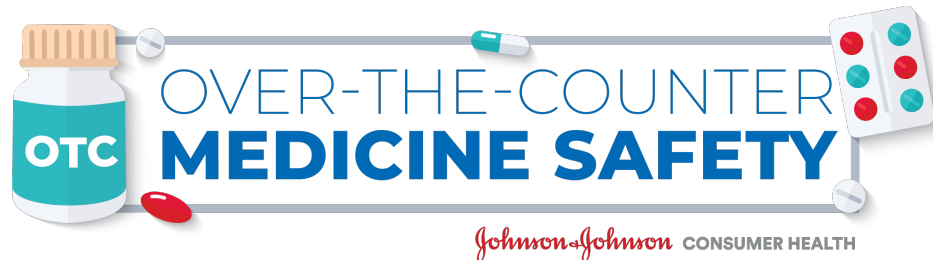

  - Safe medication storage

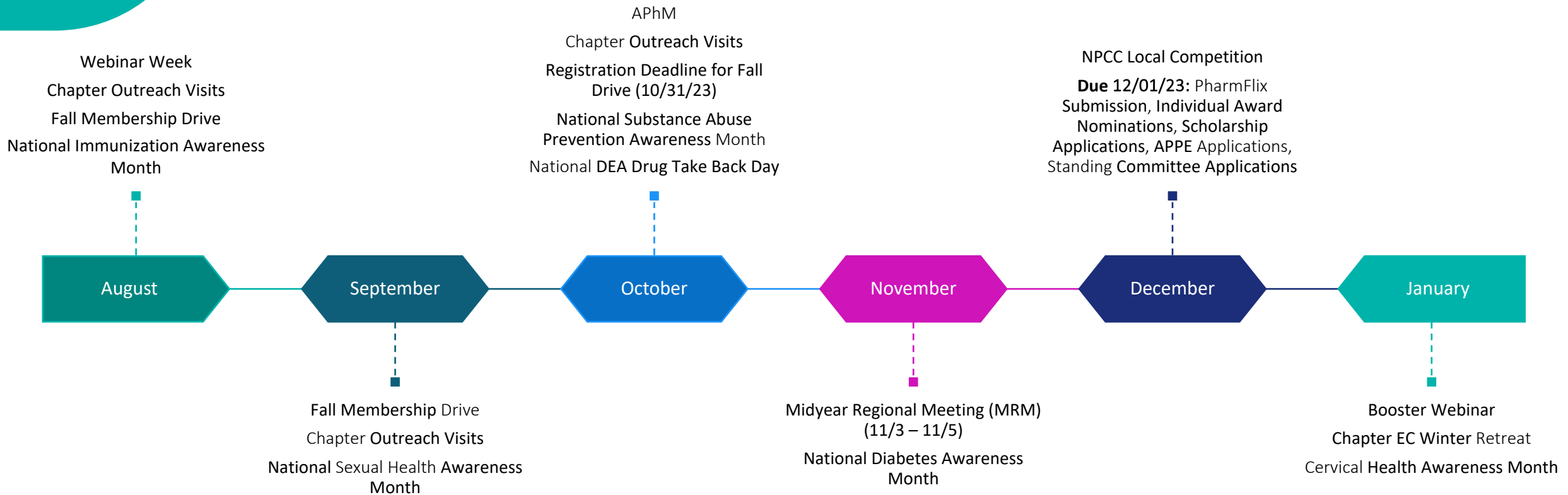
